"Our committee believes a targeted removal program of grey seals is necessary at this time to preser stocks," Sen. Elizabeth Hubley of P.E.I. said.

Among its recommendations, the committee calls on Health Canada to promote the cardiovascular I fatty acid-rich seal oil and explore the idea of including seal oil in the next version of the Canada For

It also wants monitors on hand to ensure seals are dispatched in a humane way.

Not everyone is on board with the committee's plan.

Liberal Sen. Mac Harb of Ottawa said his committee colleagues are wrongly blaming "marine mamn cod.

He said overfishing is to blame and that cod stocks are on the rise despite an increase in seal popula than 104,000 in the cull area.

"Science in this country will be once again put on the back burner as political games are played with management policies," he said.

"And the domestic and international outcry will further erode Canada's reputation as a responsible s oceans," he said about those in Canada and Europe opposed to seal hunts, seal food and seal appare
